

Name of Scholarship: Mt. Tahoma Scholarship

Amount of Scholarship: \$1000.

Application Date: April 1

Award Announcement: May 1

Description: This is a one-time scholarship given out as funds are available.

Brief Description: To support women pilots in their continued pursuit of aeronautical skills, both professionally and recreationally

*Any Ninety-Nine member is eligible for this scholarship who is seeking to increase proficiency or regain currency by adding a new rating or certificate by participating in a defined training activity. e.g., instrument training, seaplane, tailwheel, mountain flying, aerobatics.

*This scholarship is available to student pilots for initial flight training in obtaining their private pilots' certificate.

Scholarship requirements:

Application consists of the following:

*An essay limited to 500 words, describing the applicant's objectives in obtaining the scholarship (i.e., professional aviation career, increasing proficiency, retaining currency), and how the scholarship will be used to advance that goal.

* The essay should emphasize what this training would mean to this applicant and how the applicant would "pay it forward" to other Ninety-nines in the aviation community.

* Any supporting documentation you deem important such as:

1. Evidence of passing written and/or practical tests.
2. Current flight medical;/BFR or other pertinent training.

*Documented TOTAL cost of flight training requested and how you will pay for additional cost of training if not covered by the scholarship.

* Letter of recommendation from applicant's chapter chair member's activity level and participation in chapter activities.

Scholarship Limitations:

* Applicant must be a member of the Ninety-Nines.

*Applicant must be a current member (in good standing) of the Ninety-Nines Inc,

* Training must be completed by June of the following year of the award presentation.

Other Information:

* Scholarship will be awarded based on qualified applicant.

* Scholarship funds will be disbursed in one of two ways

1. Direct payment to instructor/agency providing services and training, or

2. Reimbursement to scholarship recipient upon receipt of supporting documents of training paid (invoices)

* For direct payment to instructor/agency: applicant must include supporting documentation from flight instructor or supporting agency regarding cost of service to complete training activity. copy of logbook and/or medical exam must be included if appropriate.

* For reimbursement; applicant must include copy of receipt for services provided by instructor/agency showing fees paid, flight instructor's certificate and contact information for the flight instructor/agency.

* Reimbursement applies only to training activity done after scholarship is received.

*Invoices shall be submitted to the Treasurer of the Mt Tahoma Chapter of the Ninety-Nines.
