- Plead for chapters to have scholarship chairmen!! Update the directory to reflect your current offices for better distribution of information.
- AI...What to do with it?
- AEMSF scholarships are available with minor changes. Applicant and Scholarship Chairmen instructions are listed [**“HERE.”**](#) PLEASE **read and follow instructions**. Anything in **RED** is important.
- What if I move? When you should not “change” chapters.
- The Ambassador Chapter is THE Online Chapter of the Ninety-Nines. It is great for pilots with crazy schedules and/or pilots who live abroad.

Directly from the Trustee; Most common mistakes that disqualify applicants:

- If you don't update March 5 reporting deadline, you'll no longer considered.
- Letter of recommendation is weak, hasn't been updated.
- Read the directions and make sure to follow them
- Looking for a regular essay written with the aid of spell check; OK if applicants use AI to get a basic skeleton, but polish it, make it personal, make sure it flows. Spend more time on the essay. Let your teacher, friends, and others help you. Have a good "hook".
- Start in advance of deadlines
- You can add flight logs to an application (added in for continuity) with an additional logbook entry. Add a comment to the logbook change (these are extra hours).
- Start training after you are awarded scholarship - training performed prior to award announcement will not be reimbursed.
