
FRIDAY—AUGUST 23:

Spudnuts, Tour of B Reactor, and Alphabet Houses:

An exclusive tour of the history of Richland, a town built to accommodate the workers operating and supporting the world's first large-scale plutonium producing reactor--the B Reactor. Your adventure begins with a Spudnut at Richland's oldest coffee shop established in 1948...then on to touring the Atomic City with the Alphabet Houses & People...a community built with a singular commitment to ending World War II...each housing design was assigned an alphabet letter...each home had a personal story.

Our next stop is to join the Manhattan Project National Historic Park B Reactor tour. Built by the Army Corps of Engineers and the DuPont Corporation, B Reactor is a National Historic Landmark and joins Mount Rushmore and the White House as one of America's most important historic sites.

You will receive your own personal Dupus Boomer book created by R.E. (Dick) Donnell, filled with humorous cartoons from the 1940s depicting life in the early days of the developing town of Richland.
