Governor's Gab

This spring I want to draw everyone's attention to the activities of several chapters. Wyoming now boasts eleven members. At their first in-person chapter meetup in Cheyenne on April 12th, they discussed the 2025 Air Race Classic's stops in Gilette and Rock Springs, WY, and what they want to achieve as individuals and Ninety-Nines, among other topics. Mid-Columbia is to airmark their first compass rose in Richland, WA, on May 24 at 8 am, and they welcome your help! Columbia Cascade has put forward numerous candidates for scholarships, and the 2025 section scholarship of \$1500 went to Gabrielle Scholtz (see https://nw99s.org/p/38/Announcing-the-winner-of-the-2025-Patty-Mitchell-Northwest-Section).

Membership: As of May 2025, we have 630 members in the section, of which 138 are student pilots. I recommend that every Ninety-Nine reading this takes the initiative to introduce herself and to reach out to those listed on the Membership Directory at https://www.ninety-nines.org as on Standby (1 month past due on paying dues) or on Hold (2 months past due). We don't want to lose any of our wonderful women pilots! Perhaps your chapter has a membership chair to help with this important task.

Section Activities/Outreach: We stay in touch with this beautifully designed Northwest Navigator.

As you may have heard, the Air Race Classic, the only all-women US air race, is coming to the Northwest this year! Racing teams will take off from Fairhope, AL, on June 17 and reach the terminus in Spokane, WA, by June 20. The racers will pass through the Northwest with stops at KGCC (Gillette, Wyoming), KRKS (Rock Springs, Wyoming), KJER (Jerome, Idaho), KLGD (La Grande, Oregon), and KSFF (Spokane). Multiple teams have registered from the Northwest region! Intermountain chapter is coordinating welcoming activities at the terminus, Mid-Columbia chapter members will volunteer at the KLGD stop, and Wyoming chapter members will help at KGCC and KRKS.

Some of the other regional events that 99s will attend this spring and summer include:

- Airshow of the Cascades, Madras, OR (S33), August 22-23
- Hood River OR Fly-In at Jernstedt (4S2), hosted by the Western Antique Aeroplane & Automobile Museum (WAAAM), September 6-7

Northwest Section Elections are Coming!

Every two years the NWS holds elections for the officers of our section. Per the standard operating procedures, every odd year we elect a Governor, Vice Governor, Treasurer, Secretary, the Nominating Committee, and three Directors. The Directors are elected and the election results are announced at the fall Annual Business Meeting, which this year will be held in Butte, MT, October 3-5 (https://nw99s.org/meetings).

The Northwest Section officers election will take place in June. Voting will open June 1 electronically via ElectionBuddy and members who have NOT opted out of electronic voting will receive paper ballots which must be postmarked no later than June 25. According to the International 99s Headquarters, the NWS has 634 members in good standing, with 42 member who have opted for a paper ballot. The link for ElectionBuddy will be sent by email and will also be posted on the NWS website. Chapter officers will also be asked to encourage their members to vote—we are all better when we are actively participating in our chapter, section, and international activities!
