

Dear women pilots of the Northwest,

Have you been connecting and re-connecting with your chapter members in the new year? Look out for an email soon about registering for the Spring section meeting, but plans are also in the works for the Northwest Section of the Ninety-Nines fall conference in beautiful Teton Valley (Driggs), Idaho, August 27-30, 2026. While meeting registration is not yet happening, the resort is already taking reservations. Please join and follow our [Private Facebook Group](#) created specifically for this event, ensuring you stay up to date with all the details as they become available.

If you are new to the section meeting, it means a chance to learn more about what the Ninety-Nines are all about. All current NWS 99s and your guests are welcome (guests can attend everything except the actual business meeting on Saturday the 29th). The local airport for GA flying is Driggs Reed Memorial (KDIJ), while commercial flights are available via Idaho Falls (KIDA), Jackson Hole (KJAC), or West Yellowstone (KWYS).

The main conference hotel is Teton Peaks Resort, which has lodge rooms (King or Two Queen) available at \$149 + tax per night for our group. The resort also offers alternative lodging options—RV sites, sites for camper vans, tiny homes, and glamping tents—on an as-available basis, not part of the reserved block. Due to its proximity to Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, WE RECOMMEND YOU BOOK LODGING VERY EARLY! You can cancel before June 28 for a full refund, but we expect the resort to sell out.

In the fall of 2025, the spirit of aviation proved that it knows no borders as the Wyoming, Colorado, and Pikes Peak Chapters of The Ninety-Nines joined forces for a historic cross-section collaboration. Bridging the gap between the Northwest and Southwest Sections, these three chapters organized an ambitious 30-day Poker Run fundraiser running from September 15 through October 18.

Pilots took to the skies to build their winning hands, visiting a network of two Wyoming FBOs (Torrington KTOR and Pine Bluffs 82V) and five in Colorado (Sterling KSTO, Colorado Air & Space Port KCFO, Meadow Lake KFLY, Fremont County 1V6, and Rocky Mtn Metro KBJC). This unique partnership was designed not only to raise funds but to strengthen the bonds between chapters that, while geographically adjacent, usually operate independently within their respective section boundaries.
