This year I attended the International Board of Directors March meeting in Oklahoma City in person, adding two days to the trip so I'd have a chance for more networking with Ninety-Nines and being a tourist. At the Council of Governors meeting the first night I was chosen for a one-year term as spokesperson, to start in July at the International Conference in San Diego.

Some news from four chapters: The Intermountain chapter hosts many educational activities and often works in conjunction with the Coeur d'Alene Airport Association and the Washington Pilots Association chapter in Spokane to promote women in aviation throughout the region. The Montana chapter counts airmarking as a fun summer event and host occasional hot springs visits or paint-and-sips. Columbia Cascade held a facilities tour at Aurora Airport and visited Life Flight, Van's Aircraft, and Columbia Helicopters. Eastern Idaho is involved with Young Eagles, the Teton High School aviation program, and a "Valley to the Sky" literacy program plus working like crazy on the August section conference. Idaho, Wyoming, and Mount Tahoma are all also doing a great job with youth and member engagement.

Some of the events where our Ninety-Nines staff booths and had a presence in spring 2026 include:

- Northwest Aviation Conference & Trade Show, February 21-22, Washington State Fairgrounds, Puyallup, WA. Western Washington chapter chair Cecilia Aragon was a keynote speaker.
- Alaska Airlines Aviation Day in May at Horizon Air Maintenance Facility at Portland, OR (KPDJ)
- Oregon International Airshow in Hillsboro (KHIO), May 15-17, booth by Columbia Cascade 99s

The 2026 Patty Mitchell Northwest Section of the Ninety-Nines Scholarship was quite competitive this year, so a team of judges was formed. The prize went to Lillian Mutch of the Oregon Pines chapter in April.

Our chapters sponsor scholarships as well, including the Bless Your Heart, Nancy K. Jensen, Rising Star, On-Course Milestone, and Final Approach Checkride scholarships. Our spring Board of Directors meeting took place in East Wenatchee, Washington (Pangborn Memorial, KEAT), on April 18. Vice Governor Bonnie Molitor arranged the hotel and activities.

Our upcoming Annual Business Meeting at Teton Peaks Resort and at the airport in Driggs, Idaho, promises to be an unforgettable event. During August 27-30 we will have the chance to enjoy the gorgeous mountain views and camaraderie, hosted by the Eastern Idaho and Idaho chapters.

The monthly International 99s Chapter Chair Roundtables via Zoom are hosted by Susan Steeb of the San Luis Obispo chapter, Southwest Section. This happens the fourth Wednesday of every month, 5:30-7 pm Pacific time. Topics have included bylaws, SOPs, tax forms, board accountability to chapter, airmarking, museums, and the Forest of Friendship 50th Anniversary, Websites, tech (Slack, What's App, Discord, etc.), social media, marketing, elections and voting, recruitment, retention, membership committee, and mentorship programs. Let me, Susan herself, or your chapter chair know if you would like the Zoom link for the next meeting or would like the recording. In the future, if no one in your chapter leadership is attending, maybe *you* should be the one to watch and bring back the inspiring ideas to your chapter!

If you are new to the section meeting, it's a chance to learn more about what the Ninety-Nines are all about. All current NWS 99s and your guests are welcome (guests can attend everything except the actual business meeting on Saturday the 29th). The local airport for GA flying is Driggs Reed Memorial (KDIJ), while commercial flights are available via Idaho Falls (KIDA), Jackson Hole (KJAC), or West Yellowstone (KWYS).

The main conference hotel is Teton Peaks Resort, which has lodge rooms (King or Two Queen) available at \$149 + tax per night for our group. The resort also offers alternative lodging options—RV sites, sites for camper vans, tiny homes, and glamping tents—on an as-available basis, not part of the reserved block. Due to its proximity to Yellowstone and Grand Teton National Parks, WE RECOMMEND YOU BOOK LODGING VERY EARLY! You can cancel before June 28 for a full refund, but we expect the resort to sell out.

Review the Lodging and FAQ Document (available in the [Members Section of the NW Section website](#)) of for the resort's address and phone number. You'll find maps and detailed instructions on how to book lodging and pricing for alternative lodging options. The policies for our group differ from their website. You may add up to three days before or after the event at the group rate to take advantage of all the opportunities for scenic flying, hiking, shopping, or floating down the Teton River.



## Saving Mansfield Airport (8W3)



Mid-Columbia Ninety-Nines flew into 8W3 for breakfast

In 2025, the Chelan-Douglas Regional Port Authority approached the Town of Mansfield and announced it was considering closure of Mansfield Airport (8W3). At first glance, the outlook appeared unfavorable. However, it soon became clear that the Port Authority and Mansfield residents had different priorities, and a significant disconnect existed between the agency and the airport's actual use and value to the community.

In response, Mansfield residents began educating themselves about aviation and reaching out to pilots. It didn't take long before

aircraft were arriving from all directions in support. The aviation community proved to be exceptionally engaged and supportive. Organizations such as the Washington Pilots Association and AOPA played a key role in advocating for Mansfield Airport, and the Town owes them considerable gratitude. The loss of Mansfield Airport would not only impact the local community, but also the broader aviation network.

A critical issue emerged in the Port's data analysis: flight activity had been measured primarily using ADS-B-equipped aircraft, despite the fact that many rural flights do not utilize ADS-B systems. As a result, actual traffic volumes were estimated to be approximately 50% higher than initially reported.

The Port had also explored selling Mansfield Airport for \$413,000. However, after residents created a Mansfield Airport (8W3) Facebook page, awareness quickly spread throughout the Pacific Northwest. Support poured in from across the region, and the professionalism and cooperation demonstrated by the aviation community played a significant role in prompting the Port to reconsider its position.

One of the primary concerns raised by pilots was the deteriorating condition of the runway. Over time, expanding cracks had resulted in rough landings and discouraged use. In response, the Port Authority partnered with Douglas County Transportation & Land Services (TLS) to complete runway repairs at a substantially lower cost than originally estimated. Pilots who have since landed at Mansfield have consistently praised the improved smoothness and overall quality of the runway.

Looking ahead, the Port Authority has indicated plans to return to the airport to inspect the improvements, as well as repaint and restripe the runway. They have also encouraged interested parties to inquire about leasing opportunities for new hangar development.

Ultimately, the Port Authority voted to postpone the sale of Mansfield Airport for a period of five years. During this time, air traffic levels will continue to be monitored to evaluate the airport's viability and justify the investment of public funds. While some remain optimistic, others caution that without sustained attention and use, activity levels could decline.

Now is a critical time to support Mansfield Airport. Pilots are encouraged to continue flying into this small, historic town—where visitors can land, step back in time, and walk just a block to enjoy a welcoming meal at the Town Bar & Grill, known for its great food and small-town hospitality.

The Town of Mansfield and the Chelan-Douglas Regional Port Authority continue to work collaboratively to determine the best path forward for the airport's long-term success.

## Flying West ~ Kitty (Kathryn) Curl

It is with a heavy heart that I share the news that our beloved sister aviator, Kitty Curl, passed away on April 30th surrounded by family.

Many of you knew Kitty well, her smile and laughter at chapter meetings, her adventurous spirit, and her willingness to help in any way she could. She embodied everything the Ninety-Nines stands for: sisterhood, service, and a deep love of flight.

Kitty's aviation story is a testament to the adventurous spirit that made her so special. At 70, her son Ryan took her on a Mother's Day scenic flight, and something clicked. She decided she wanted to become a pilot. She began flight training and earned her wings 18 months later at the age of 71.

She joined the 99s in 2017, and served as our chapter treasurer for many years. It was her dedication that kept our accounts intact through nearly four years of dormancy, allowing us to pick right back up when the chapter came back to life. She held a lifetime membership in the Ninety-Nines and attended every meeting and event she could. Her presence made this chapter better in ways that are hard to measure.

We extend our deepest condolences to her family, and ask that you keep them especially in your thoughts this Mother's Day. Ryan has named her plane "Kitty's Hawk" and will carry on her legacy by continuing to fly it in Young Eagles events. In a beautiful tribute to his mom, he has a flight planned this Sunday to drop her 99s items to me in Driggs.

On behalf of our Eastern Idaho Chapter, I had the honor of delivering a small token of our support to Kitty's husband Bob: some food, flowers, and a card expressing our deepest condolences. Details on a memorial service will be shared as they become available. In the meantime, if you have a story, a photo, or a memory of Kitty you'd like to share, please send it my way so we can compile something meaningful to honor her life.

Traditionally, the annual Palms to Pines Air Race takes place each summer at the end of July or beginning of August, with teams flying from Santa Monica to central Oregon (approximately 750 statute miles).

The race ran consecutively for 40 years until 2009, making it the longest-running all-female air race. Each year, anywhere from 30-60 planes participated with teams or solo pilots from all over the western United States. After a hiatus, in 2022, the race returned, now organized by the LA99s.
